Background

On September 16, 2019, Town of Jupiter Island, Florida, ("Petitioner") timely filed a petition with DOAH to challenge whether the Martin County Comprehensive Plan Amendment adopted by Ordinance No. 1107 on August 27, 2019, is in compliance, as defined in section 163.3184(1)(b), Florida Statutes. Martin County was listed as the Respondent.

On November 15, 2019, the parties filed a Joint Stipulation of Settlement and Dismissal, notifying DOAH that a dispute of material facts no longer exists. On December 9, 2019, because the parties resolved the issue by settlement agreement, the ALJ filed the Second Amended Order Closing File and relinquished jurisdiction to the Department to issue a final order.

A DOCUMENT IS FILED WHEN IT IS RECEIVED. THE NOTICE OF APPEAL MUST BE SUBSTANTIALLY IN THE FORM PRESCRIBED BY FLORIDA RULE OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE 9.900(A).

AN ADVERSELY AFFECTED PARTY WAIVES THE RIGHT TO JUDICIAL REVIEW IF THE NOTICE OF APPEAL IS NOT TIMELY FILED WITH BOTH THE DEPARTMENT'S AGENCY CLERK AND THE APPROPRIATE DISTRICT COURT OF APPEAL.
