# FINAL ORDER OF DISMISSAL

**THIS MATTER** comes before the Department of Management Services ("Department") for entry of a Final Order of Dismissal in accordance with section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes.

# **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- On October 3, 2019, pursuant to Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code,

  Neville Castle filed an Amended Petition for Formal Administrative Hearing with
  the Department of Management Services disputing the denial of certain health
  benefits.
- 2. Thereafter, Petitioner voluntarily withdrew the *Petition for Administrative Hearing* via email on January 7, 2020. Further action is time barred.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

3. In administrative proceedings, agency jurisdiction ceases to exist when a petition is withdrawn or voluntarily dismissed. *Rudloe v. Florida Department of Environmental Regulation*, 517 So. 2d 731, 732 (Fla. 1st DCA 1987).

4. This matter is now due to be dismissed because the Department's jurisdiction ceased when Petitioner voluntarily dismissed the petition.

# It is hereby **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED**:

- 1. Petitioner's request for formal administrative hearing is hereby DISMISSED; and
- 2. This Final Order shall become effective on the date of filing with the Agency Clerk of the Department of Management Services.
