FINAL ORDER OF DISMISSAL

THIS MATTER comes before the Department of Management Services ("Department") for entry of a Final Order of Dismissal in accordance with section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On September 17, 2019, pursuant to Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code, Aviation West Charters, d/b/a, Angel MedFlight sent a letter attempting to "collect a debt" which was correctly deemed by the Respondent's General Counsel's Office as a Petition for Formal Administrative Hearing filed with the Department of Management Services disputing the denial of certain health benefits on behalf of subscriber Deborah Meisenburg who is deceased.
- On November 15, 2019, the matter was referred to the Division of Administrative Hearings.
- Thereafter, Angel MedFlight voluntarily withdrew the petition via email on December 13,
 2019. Further action is time barred.
- 4. According to a published obituary, Deborah Meisenburg died on January 5, 2019.

 The Division of Administrative Hearings issued an Order Closing File and Relinquishing Jurisdiction on January 7, 2020.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- In administrative proceedings, agency jurisdiction ceases to exist when a petition is withdrawn or voluntarily dismissed. Rudloe v. Florida Department of Environmental Regulation, 517 So. 2d 731, 732 (Fla. 1st DCA 1987).
- This matter is now due to be dismissed because the Department's jurisdiction ceased when Petitioner voluntarily dismissed the petition.

It is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

- Petitioner's request for formal administrative hearing is hereby DISMISSED; and
- This Final Order shall become effective on the date of filing with the Agency Clerk of the Department of Management Services.
