Upon consideration of the Settlement Agreement, which is attached hereto, and being fully advised of the premises, it is hereby **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED**:


1. The Settlement Agreement as submitted is hereby approved, adopted, and incorporated herein by reference.

that motor vehicle dealer license number VI-1003435 is hereby REVOKED effective immediately. Respondent shall surrender its license and all dealer and temporary tags in its possession to the Division of Motorist Services and cease doing business immediately.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL**

A party adversely affected by this final order may seek judicial review as provided in section 120.68, Florida Statutes, and Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.190. Judicial review is initiated by filing a notice of appeal with the Agency Clerk, and a copy of the notice of appeal, accompanied by the filing fee, with the appropriate district court of appeal. The notice of appeal must conform to the requirements of Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.110(d), and must be filed (i.e., received by the Agency Clerk) within thirty (30) days of rendition of this final order.
