FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the BOARD OF MASSAGE (Board) pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, at the properly noticed meeting on July 8, 2021, in Panama City Beach, Florida, for the purpose of considering the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order (RO), (a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A) in the above-styled cause. - 4. A final hearing was scheduled for January 2021 later rescheduled and conducted by Zoom Video Conference on March 4 and 5, 2021.
- 5. At the hearing, Petitioner was represented by Ann Prescott and Julisa Renaud, Assistant General Counsels for the Department of Health.
 - 6. Richard A Greenberg, Esq., appeared for Respondent.
- 7. Administrative Law Judge, Brian A. Newman, (ALJ) issued a Recommended Order on May 26, 2021.
 - 8. No exceptions were filed.
- 9. After review of the complete record in this case; the Board makes the following findings and conclusions:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 10. There is competent substantial evidence to support the findings of fact.
- 11. The findings of fact set forth in the Recommended Order are approved and adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 12. The Board has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, and Chapter 480, Florida Statutes.
- The conclusions of law set forth in the Recommended Order are approved and adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

PENALTY

Upon a complete review of the record in this case, the Board determines that the recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge is ACCEPTED.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

Complaints, 2018-04422, and Administrative Both 2020-07089 filed against Respondent are DISMISSED.
