FINAL ORDER

The Department issued a Notice of Intent to Modify Driveway Connection (Notice) to John and Kathryn Maassen, the listed property owners, on March 1, 2021. The Notice proposed that the existing 100-foot wide State Road 70 (Oak Street) driveway connection to the Maassen property leased to the DeSoto Sign company would be closed pursuant to the Department's design efforts to improve safety and operations as part of the State Road 70 Roadway Improvement and Reconstruction Project. On March 25, 2021, Petitioner, David L. Maassen (Maassen), on behalf of the deceased property owners as the surviving heir, and who is responsible for the commercial property leased to DeSoto Sign, filed a timely Request for Administrative Hearing with the Department challenging the Notice.

On May 11, 2021, this case was referred to the Division of Administrative Hearings, and a hearing by Zoom Conference was conducted before the assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ), Lynne A. Quimby-Pennock, on July 16, 2021. The ALJ entered a Recommended Order (Order) on September 28, 2021, finding that the Department proved by a preponderance of the evidence that the closure of Petitioner's driveway connection to State Road 70 will improve safety and the operational characteristics on the roadway, and will provide Petitioner with reasonable access

through the indirect connection on Baldwin Avenue. The Order also recommended that the Department enter a final order approving the closure of the property's 100-foot driveway as part of the State Road 70 project. A copy of the Recommended Order is attached. None of the parties filed exceptions to the Recommended Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Findings of Fact set forth in paragraphs 1-42 of the Recommended Order are supported by competent, substantial evidence and the Department adopts the Findings of Fact set forth in paragraphs 1-42 of the Recommended Order and incorporates them by reference.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Conclusions of Law set forth in paragraphs 43-57 of the Recommended Order are supported by law and the Department adopts the Conclusions of Law set forth in paragraphs 43-57 of the Recommended Order and incorporates them by reference.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Department approves the proposed closure of the Maassens' property's 100-foot driveway connection to SR 70 and finds the closure will improve safety and operational characteristics on SR 70, and will provide Petitioner with reasonable access to SR 70 through the indirect connection on Baldwin Avenue.
