THIS CAUSE is before the Department of Children and Families ("Department") for entry of a Final Order concerning the Department's Administrative Complaint dated April 27, 2021, which seeks to impose a \$50 fine based on Respondent's failure to have an employee background screened following a break in employment of 90 or more days, as required by sections 5.2 C and 7.4.1 C of the Child Care Facility Handbook incorporated by reference in Rule 65C-22.001, *Florida Administrative Code*. Following an administrative hearing, the Administrative Law Judge concluded that the Department did not prove this violation by clear and convincing evidence and therefore recommended dismissal of the Administrative Complaint. Neither party filed exceptions to the Recommended Order.

There being no reason to reject or modify the findings of fact or conclusions of law in the Recommended Order, the Recommended Order is adopted *in toto* and the Department's Administrative Complaint is **DISMISSED**.
