FINAL ORDER

This matter comes before the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles from a Settlement Agreement entered into between the parties, dated July 21, 2021. On April 28, 2021, the Department filed an Administrative Complaint against Petitioner pursuant to §§ 120.569 and 120.57(1) and (2), Fla. Stat., and Chapter 28-106, Parts I, II, and III, Fla. Admin. Code. The parties have entered into a Settlement Agreement resolving all disputes arising from the Administrative Complaint. The Settlement Agreement's terms appear reasonable and acceptable to the Department. Therefore, the terms of the Settlement Agreement, a copy of which is attached, are approved and incorporated into this Final Order. The parties are directed to abide by the Settlement Agreement according to its terms.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** that the Settlement Agreement is incorporated into this Final Order and, therefore, the case is **CLOSED**.

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NOTICE OF APPEAL RIGHTS

A party adversely affected by this final order may seek judicial review as provided in § 120.68, Fla. Stat., and Fla. R. App. P. 9.190. Judicial review is initiated by filing a notice of appeal with the Agency Clerk, and a copy of the notice of appeal, accompanied by the filing fee, with the appropriate district court of appeal. The notice of appeal must conform to the requirements of Fla. R. App. P. 9.110(d) and must be filed (*i.e.*, received by the Agency Clerk) within thirty days of rendition of this final order.
