**FINAL ORDER ADOPTING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

This matter comes before the Department for entry of a Final Order Adopting Settlement Agreement entered into between the parties in this cause.

On May 10, 2021, the Department sent a Notice of Intent to Deny letter to Ted Vernon Specialty Automobiles noticing it of the Department’s intent to deny the 2021 Renewal Application for license number VI-1008842. On January 21, 2022, the Department and Respondent entered into a Settlement Agreement, to resolve all matters at issue in Department Case Number MS-21-262 and DOAH Case Number 21-2096.

Upon consideration of the Settlement Agreement, which is attached hereto, and being fully advised of the premises, it is hereby **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:**

1. The Settlement Agreement as submitted is hereby approved, adopted, and incorporated herein by reference.
2. The parties shall adhere to and abide by all the terms and conditions of the Settlement Agreement.
3. Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, the entry of this Order shall render the Hearing Officer’s Recommended Order issued in DOAH Case Number 21-2096 on January 13,


2022 as moot and having no effect of law.

4. Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, the Parties agree to bear their own costs and attorneys fees.

5. Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, the Petitioner has waived its rights to appeal this Final Order.
