## FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before me for final action on Everything Sweet, Inc.'s ("Respondent") request for administrative review ("petition") challenging a Stop-Work Order and Order of Penalty Assessment ("Stop-Work Order"), an Amended Order of Penalty Assessment, and a 2nd Amended Order of Penalty Assessment.

### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On February 5, 2018, the Department of Financial Services, Division of Workers' Compensation ("Department"), served Respondent the Stop-Work Order.
- 2. On April 18, 2018, the Department served Respondent an Amended Order of Penalty Assessment. The Amended Order of Penalty Assessment assessed a total penalty of \$28,884.74.
  - 3. On May 4, 2018, the Department received Respondent's petition.
- 4. On August 13, 2021, the Department referred the petition to the Division of Administrative Hearings ("DOAH").

- On August 23, 2021, the Department served Respondent a 2nd Amended Order of Penalty Assessment. The 2nd Amended Order of Penalty Assessment assessed a total penalty of \$28,791.26.
- 6. On October 19, 2021, DOAH entered an order deeming matters admitted and relinquishing jurisdiction to the Department. A true and correct copy of the order is attached hereto as exhibit "1."
- 7. The factual allegations contained in the Stop-Work Order, and the 2nd Amended Order of Penalty Assessment are hereby adopted as the Department's findings of fact in this case.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

8. Based upon the findings of fact adopted herein, the Department concludes
Respondent violated the specific statutes and rules as alleged in the Stop-Work Order and the
2nd Amended Order of Penalty Assessment.

# Accordingly:

- a. Respondent shall immediately execute a payment agreement or pay the penalty of \$28,791.26 in full to the Department for deposit into the Workers' Compensation Administration Trust Fund.
- b. Respondent shall immediately cease all business operations in the State of Florida until such time as the Department issues an order releasing the Stop-Work Order and the 2nd Amended Order of Penalty Assessment. The Department shall not issue an order releasing the Stop-Work Order and the 2nd Amended Order of Penalty Assessment until Respondent has come into compliance with the coverage requirements of chapter 440, Florida Statutes, and has

paid the total penalty of \$28,791.26 to the Department.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL

The notice of appeal must conform to the requirements of Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.110(d), and must be filed (i.e., received by the Agency Clerk) within thirty days of rendition of this final order.
