## FINAL ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This matter comes before the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles for entry of a Final Order Approving Settlement Agreement entered into between the parties in this cause.

On April 11, 2022, the Department and Respondent entered into a Settlement Agreement to resolve the pending charges alleged on April 28, 2021, in the Administrative Complaint.

Upon consideration of the Settlement Agreement, which is attached hereto, and being fully advised of the premises, it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED**:

- The Settlement Agreement as submitted is corrected as to case number (from MS-21-131 to MS-21-231), approved, adopted, and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. The parties shall adhere to and abide by all terms and conditions of the Settlement Agreement.
- 3. Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, Respondent shall pay a civil fine in the amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) within 15 days from the date of filing of this final order.
- 4. Failure to pay the civil fine will result in the Department's suspending Respondent's license until such time that Respondent complies with the terms of this final order.

THIS FINAL ORDER SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE UPON FILING WITH THE AGENCY CLERK OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAY SAFETY AND MOTOR VEHICLES.
