No attempt has been made to show all change center or other data.

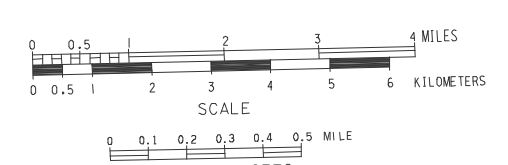
City populations are taken from the U.S. Census for 1990.
