REGISTRATION STATUS

BUDWOOD CAN ONLY BE CUT FROM TREES THAT HAVE A “REG” or “CERT” IN THE REG. COLUMN.

- REG = Registered**
- CERT = Certified**
- SUSP – Registration Suspended**

This certificate lists budwood or seed source trees that are entered into the Citrus Budwood Protection Program. These trees may be of one of the following categories:

Increase Block Source Trees

Increase Blocks expire 36 months from budding date. The 36th month expiration date is from the date of budding on the original Source Tree Bud Cutting Report, FDACS-08172, Rev. 03/14, incorporated in Rule 5B-62.005, F.A.C., which serves as the Certificate for Increase Block Trees.

Enter the BCR# of the Increase Block bud cutting report in the column “Increase Trees enter BCR#” when cutting budwood from an Increase Block.

Scion Grove Source Trees

Certificates for Scion Grove Source Trees expire January 31 of the following year. This certificate lists all trees in this scion planting which must be registered annually. Only those trees meeting requirements of Chapter 5B-62, F.A.C. will be certified as registered. Budwood trees not registered must be removed from the greenhouse.

Enter the Tree ID# in the column “Scion Trees enter Tree ID#” when cutting budwood from Scion Trees.
