Appointments are required for persons sitting for all LP gas examinations. No walk-ins will be accepted. To schedule an exam, you must:

1. Return the completed form to the Division of Consumer Services at the address indicated, along with the appropriate examination fee. (Make checks payable to "Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services" or "FDACS").
2. MASTER QUALIFIER EXAMINEES: Must provide proof of previously passing a Qualifier examination; must complete Master Qualifier Declaration of Eligibility (FDACS-03527 Rev. 02/14) indicating your status within the company.

Once the division headquarters in Tallahassee has received the form and fee, you will be contacted and advised of your examination date. Examination requests should be submitted at least two weeks in advance.
