## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

Section 1: Complete all entries. Ensure telephone and fax numbers are current so that the Bureau can contact you for coordination purposes. If you have a cell number, please provide it as well. Confirmation of your request will be made by e-mail or fax to the number you provide on the same day of the request or within one working day. If you do not get a return e-mail or fax confirming your request for inspection, call the Bureau. The Bureau will not confirm requests for re-inspection, therefore you must call to confirm re-inspection request.

Section 2: Complete all entries. Circle "Inspection" if you are requesting initial inspection. If you are requesting a Stop Operation or Out of Service tag or removal release of an Immediate Final Order, circle "Re-Inspection."

Date Arrive on Site means the day amusement rides arrive on the lot or event site and are available for inspection.

**Date of Inspection** means the day you want the state inspector to inspect the ride(s).

**Date and Time of First Intended Use** means the day the rides will be open to patrons or the start of the event. The date of inspection and date and time of first intended use should match unless early opening is needed on the first intended use date.

Close Date means the date the ride(s) close to the public (note: for permanent facilities this date may be left blank).

Number of Rides to be Inspected means the total ride count for this event, and it must match the number listed in Section 3.

Event Name is self explanatory, i.e. name of a festival, church or county fair. For permanent facilities, list the name of the park.

**Exact Location: City and Street** means the address of the event of location where rides will be inspected. Provide directions and landmarks to assist the inspector in finding the locations.

Section 3: Complete all entries. List all rides to be inspected by Ride Name, Manufacturer's Name, Model Number, Serial Number, USAID Number, and Owner. If any of this information is not known, indicate as "unknown." Ride Name means the theme name of the ride. USAID number means the United States Amusement Identification Number. This is a metal license type plate (white background, black numbers) issued previously. If a USAID plate has not been issued and the ride is new to Florida, indicate as "New." Owner means the entity that the rides are permitted to. Ensure that the number of rides listed in this section match the total number in section 2.

CANCELLATION OF REQUESTS: CANCELLATION OF A REQUEST FOR INSPECTION OF ANY NUMBER OF RIDES OUTSIDE THE VARIANCE MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE BUREAU IN WRITING AT LEAST ONE WORKING DAY PRIOR TO THE SCHEDULED DATE OF THE INSPECTION.
