### General Information

All transactions must be completed by the Primary Supervisory Appraiser. The Primary Supervisory Appraiser must notify the Division of Real Estate of the name and address of any primary and secondary supervisory appraiser and must also notify the division within 10 days after terminating such relationship. Primary, Secondary and Trainee must be affiliated with the same firm or business. Termination of a Primary Supervisor will automatically terminate the supervisory relationship with the Secondary Supervisor.

Any supervising appraiser may not supervise more than three trainee appraisers at one time. A supervisory appraiser must have been licensed as a residential or general appraiser for at least 48 months and be in good standing with the Board. A supervisory appraiser must not have had a registration, certification, or license suspended by the Board or have been disciplined by the Board in two or more disciplinary cases in the past five years.

#### 1. Application Instructions (by section)

##### a. Section I – Application Type

- i. Select the transaction you wish to complete.
- ii. This application must be completed by the Primary Supervisor.

**b. Section II – Supervisor Information**

- i. Provide the name and license number of the appraiser trainee.
- ii. Provide the name, license number, telephone number, and email address of the primary supervisor.
- iii. If you are designating a secondary supervisor, provide the name and license number of the secondary supervisor.
- iv. Provide the name and business location address of the appraisal business with which the primary supervisor is affiliated.

**c. Section III – Eligibility Criteria**

- i. Answer whether the designated supervisor currently supervises three or more trainees prior to supervising the trainee for whom this application is being completed.
- ii. Answer whether the designated supervisor is currently a licensed appraiser certified general or certified residential appraiser in good standing with the Board.
- iii. Answer the whether or not the designated supervisor has had their registration, certification, or license suspended by the Board or has been disciplined by the Board in two or more disciplinary cases in the past five years or is currently subjected to discipline or practice restrictions by the Board.

**d. Section IV – Supervisor Termination**

- i. Provide the name and license number of the appraiser trainee.
- ii. Provide the name of the supervisor who is to be terminated as a supervisor.
- iii. Indicate whether they are to be terminated as a primary or secondary supervisor.
- iv. Provide the license number of the terminated supervisor.

**e. Section V – Affirmation By Written Declaration**

- i. The affirmation by written declaration must be signed by the primary supervisor.
- ii. If the applicant fails to sign the affirmation statement, the application will be deficient and unable to be approved.
