The Principal is or intends to become a transporter of hazardous waste which is subject to the applicable governing provisions relating to financial responsibility for the protection of the public.

This bond assures compliance by the Principal with the applicable governing provisions, and shall insure to the benefit of any person or persons who shall recover a final judgment or judgments against the Principal for public liability claims (excluding injury to or death of the Principal's employees while engaged in the course of their employment, and loss of or damage to property of the Principal, and the cargo transported by the Principal).

The liability of the surety(ies) on each motor vehicle subject to the financial responsibility requirements of Florida Administrative Code Rule 62-730.170 for each accident shall not exceed \$_____, and shall be a continuing one notwithstanding any recovery hereunder.

The Surety(ies) agrees, upon telephone request by an authorized representative of the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP), to verify that the surety bond is in force as of a particular date. The telephone number to call is: _____

The Principal or the Surety(ies) may at any time terminate this bond by giving thirty (30) days notice in writing to the Secretary or designee of the FDEP and the other party (said 30 day notice to commence from the date the notice is received by both parties, evidenced by certified mail return receipt).

The Surety(ies) shall not be liable for the payment of any judgment or judgments against the Principal for public liability claims resulting from accidents which occur after the termination of this bond described herein, but such termination shall not affect the liability of the surety(ies) for the payment of any such judgment or judgments resulting from accidents which occur during the time the bond is in effect.
