

## Certification Form for the Registration of Career-Themed Courses

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Pursuant to the Florida Career and Professional Education Act, ss. 1003.491 – 1003.4935, F.S., all districts shall offer at least two career-themed courses. A career-themed course is “a course, or a course in a series of courses, that leads to an industry certification identified in the Industry Certification Funding List pursuant to rules adopted by the State Board of Education. Career-themed courses have industry-specific curriculum aligned directly to priority workforce needs established by the regional workforce board or the Department of Economic Opportunity.”

All career-themed courses shall be registered in order to be eligible to generate the additional full-time equivalent membership funding based on the completion of industry certifications (Rule 6A.6.0573, F.A.C.).
